

Gallery big draw at center

Gallery exhibits play an integral role in the ongoing activities at the William Bonifas Fine Arts Center.

Over the past 10 years, artists from all over the United States have displayed works in the gallery, which was named after the late Alice Uren-Powers of Escanaba, nationally acclaimed artist-teacher.

Coordinated by Bonifas Art Center Manager Norbert LaPorte, close to 20 shows are hung in the gallery each year.

The exhibits have drawn thousands of visitors to the Center, including student classes and tour groups.

Both Bay de Noc Community College, Escanaba, and Northern Michigan

University, Marquette, have been involved in a synergistic relationship with the Art Center.

The Detroit Institute of Arts, Cranbook Institute, Bay de Noc Indian Cultural Association, and Alma College display work as do local artists and groups like the 4-H Club.

In addition to these exhibits, the Center has its own private collection which is displayed between special shows.

There is no admission charge to the Gallery or Art Center, located at 700 1st Ave. S., Escanaba. Gallery hours are Tuesday through Friday from noon to 4 p.m. and Thursday from 7 to 9 p.m.






